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ERÄ-EERO WILDLIFE LODGE
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Erä Eero's Wildlife Lodge is located near the easternmost corner of the European Union, on the edge of the endless taiga forest that span from Finland all the way to Siberia. Our wildlife represents the distinct features of the northern-taiga forest. Also the nearness of the Russian border gives the place a special interest and the history of the area is rich.

The Wildlife Lodge is operated by Eero Kortelainen, the owner of the place all ready for ten years. Originally the lodge was the camp site for lumber jacks who worked and lived in the middle of wilderness. Now days they have been replaced by motorized harvesters, but spirit of the lumber jack still remains intact inside the traditionally renovated Wildlife Lodge and the environment. Sauna, lodging services and outdoor activities are available year-round.

Observe and film the Finland's greatest carnivores in their natural habitats year-round, while staying in our Wildlife Observation Lodge and hides, which are situated next to a beautiful wilderness lake in a valley facing an old growth forest on the other side. The landscape you'll be viewing has never been touched by humans. The rocky slope on the other side of the lake is an ideal habitat for the wolverine.

The guidelines of our work in wilderness are high ethics of respecting the wildlife and principles of eco tourism and nature conservation. By following that path chosen we guarantee the wildlife still remains wild.

Wildlife Lodge accommodates 22 persons in traditional lumber jack atmosphere, in true harmony with wilderness around.

Bearhill Eco Lodge is for 10 persons with electricity and shower possibilities.

Wildlife Observation Lodge is for groups of 8+8 persons and **Hides** for 2+3 photographers.

Welcome to enjoy the wilderness - to taste, smell, hear and see all the four taiga seasons in full flavor.
