WILD ANIMAL OBSERVATION

Season: 2011

Brown Bear April – October, other species throughout the year.

Duration:

4 pm – 6 am

Description:

Wolverines, brown bears, wolves, lynxes, golden eagles, goshawks as well as other wild animals live in the environs of EräEero. During the night you may see, hear and even film/photograph them at our beautiful location. The night is spent comfortably in Ourlog house with dining and sauna bathing options.

Cost:

1-2 persons, EUR 175 per person 3-18 person, EUR 160 per person (VAT included)

Programme:

Upon arrival to Keljanpuro Brook you receive information on location, procedures and predators and guided to the observation cabin. A snack will be served during the course of the night. In the morning we return to Keljanpuro Brook.

Included:

Guidance, snacks, insurance, use of listening device, diploma.

Languages:

Guidance provided in Finnish, English or Russian.

Please note:

Clothing suitable for weather conditions. Everybody should bring their own cameras, binoculars and recording devices.

Additional information:

Sauna, breakfast, sleeping quarters and dinner at the log house the following day provided for an additional cost of EUR 50 per person.
